Shock Doctor Eject Helmet Removal System

Removing a competitor's helmet in the event of a crash is now a no-brainer for trackside medical personnel. Eject, Shock Doctor's helmet removal system, uses a compact air bladder that fits under the crown lining. A tube runs from the bladder to the base of the helmet. Inflating the bladder via the tube and supplied screw-on squeeze bulb lifts the helmet off the wearer's head. Eject (\$70) is mandatory for all AMA Supercross and Outdoor National Motocross Series riders.
